Minor In Civil Engineering

The Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering offers a minor in Civil Engineering for students not majoring in Civil Engineering

Admission Requirements:

The applicant must have completed the School of Engineering Freshman Year courses or their equivalents, plus the following courses which are prerequisites for Civil and Environmental Engineering (CEE) courses, each with a C or better grade:

- MATH 0240 and 0250; ENGR 0131 or 0135; ENGR 0141 or 0145.

Students from other engineering departments must be in good standing. Students from outside of the School of Engineering must have an overall QPA of 2.5 or better.

Requirements for the Civil Engineering Minor:

The student must complete six CEE courses with a QPA of 2.0 or better, as detailed below.

- Four out of the following introductory courses:

CEE 1200, 1330, 1402, 1503, 1703, 1811.

- Two electives from the following five categories related to the introductory courses taken, must be taken from the list below.

CEE 1200 electives: CEE 1211, 1203, 1210.

CEE 1330 electives: CEE 1331, 1340, 1341.

CEE 1402 electives: CEE 1412, 2401, 2404, 2405.

CEE 1503 electives: CEE 1513, 1523, 2507, 2513.

CEE 1811 electives: CEE 1821, 2800, 2801, 2802, 1714, 1715, 1717.
