

Walkability Checklist

How walkable is Oakland? This checklist is a tool used to help you identify safety and/or security concerns. After completing the checklist, please use the Security Submission form to report any concerns identified.

Did you have room to walk?

- Plenty of room
- Narrow sidewalks – too much foot traffic
- Missing sidewalks in places
- Sidewalks were broken, cracked or uneven
- Sidewalks were blocked by objects, obstacles or vehicles
- No sidewalks or paths
- Stairs in need of repair

Was it easy to cross streets?

- Crossed with ease
- Road was too wide
- Traffic signals made you wait too long or did not give you enough time to cross
- Street needed a crosswalk, traffic signal or sign
- Parked cars blocked view of traffic
- Trees or plants blocked view of traffic
- Needed curb ramps or ramps needed repair

Do drivers respect pedestrians?

- Obeyed traffic/ pedestrian laws, street markings, and traffic signals or signs
- Did not yield to pedestrians crossing the street
- Turned into pedestrians crossing the street
- Sped up to make it through traffic light or drove through red traffic light
- Aggressive behavior toward bicyclists

Was it easy to follow the safety rules?

- No problems following the safety rules
- Crosswalk was faded
- Traffic sign blocked by object
- Graffiti on sign – unable to read
- Traffic markings or signs needed to enhance safety

Was your walk pleasant?

- A very pleasant walk through Oakland
- Moderate/slightly pleasant walk
- Not pleasant at all
- Not well lighted
- Scary people
- Dirty, lots of litter or trash

Campus emergency phones?

- Emergency phone was broken
- Emergency phone light was out
- Emergency phone needed in a certain location
